- **Educational Classes** for children & adults at the Mara Moja library
- **Free Meals** during longstanding droughts in the community
- **Women Empowerment** to uplift the community as a whole
- **Computer Literacy** to give access to the ever-changing digital world

Impact

- The Mara Moja library's three teachers (youth tutoring, adult literacy, and computer) ensure kids and adults are empowered
- Our feeding program ensures students are well-fed so they can participate as active learners
- Library attendance for children increased to ~40% female, and our adult literacy and student sponsorship programs are ~75% female

- Partner organizations have been vital to SAL's success in the community, offering learning resources at key times in SAL's history
- Weekly updates are shared on social media to reach wider audiences
- Donors have been integral in SAL's success, and we intend to grow the donor pool to 100+ for continued impact!

- Sponsored students (9 total, 3 currently) who would otherwise not be able to attend school, have recently seen improved academic marks
- Plumbing is necessary to accommodate the growing number of students attending classes at the SAL library
- The library requires renovations in 2024 to ensure a safe place to learn

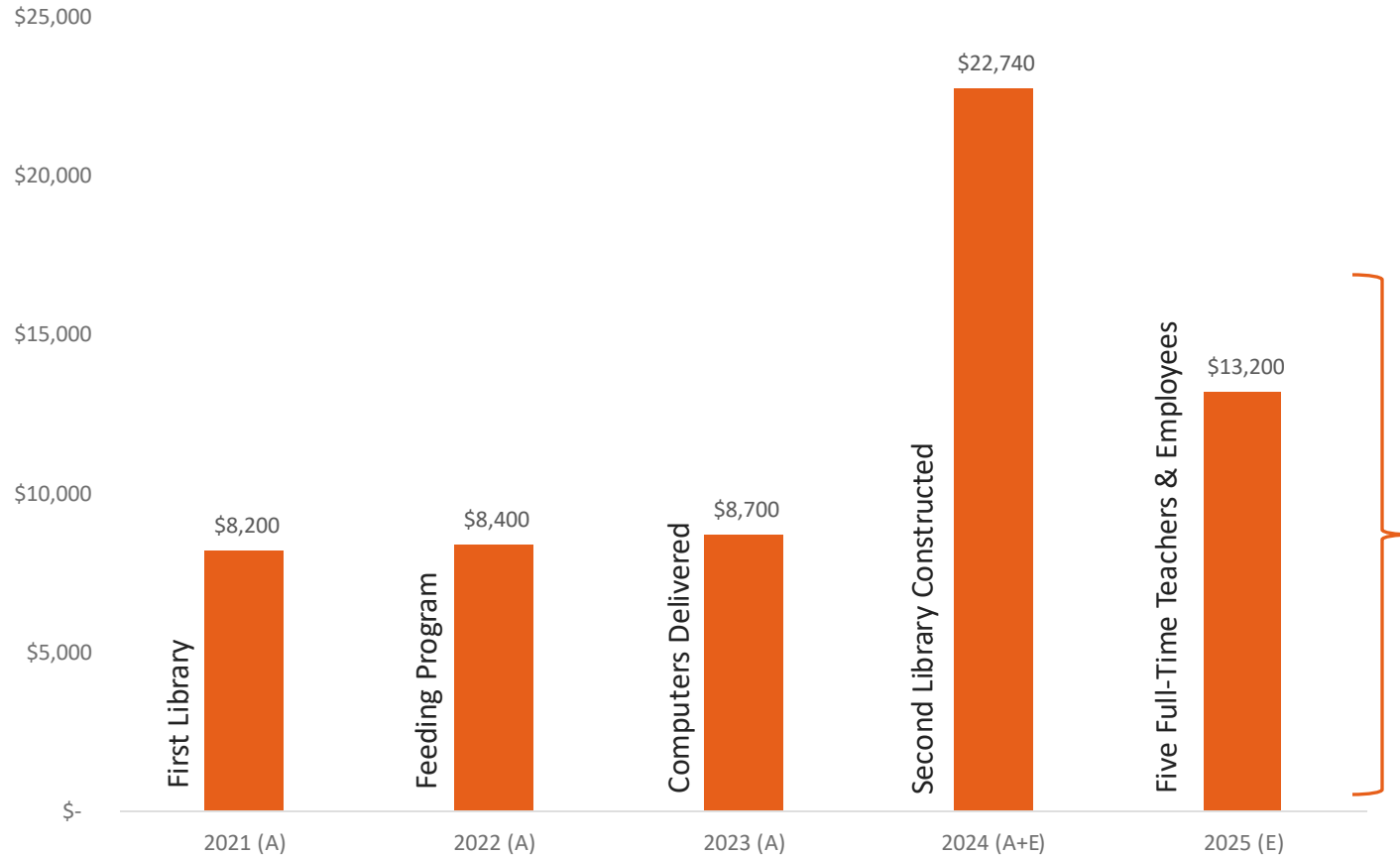


Shed A Light (SAL) Annual Budget



Shed A Light reaches ~210 unique students and ~40 unique adults through our feeding and educational programs at an average monthly cost of ~\$6 per community center visitor through low administrative and fixed expenses

Shed A Light reaches ~250 unique stakeholders through cost effective and highly impactful programs that focus on what the community needs most

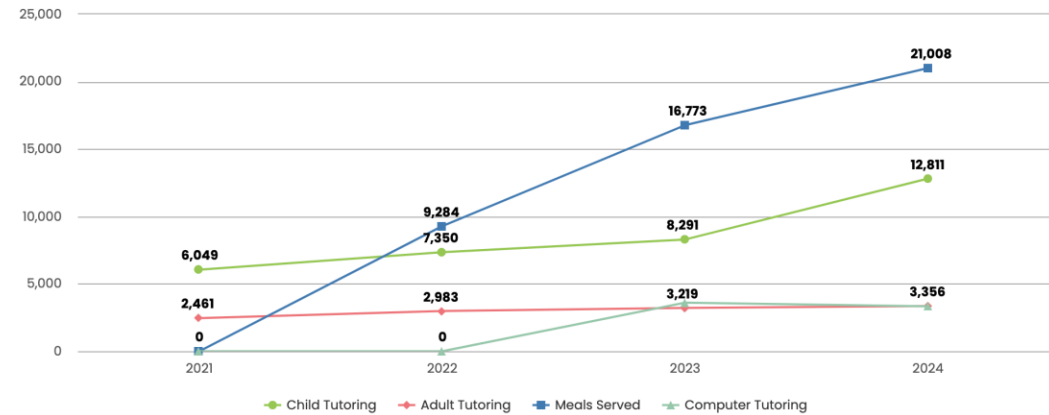

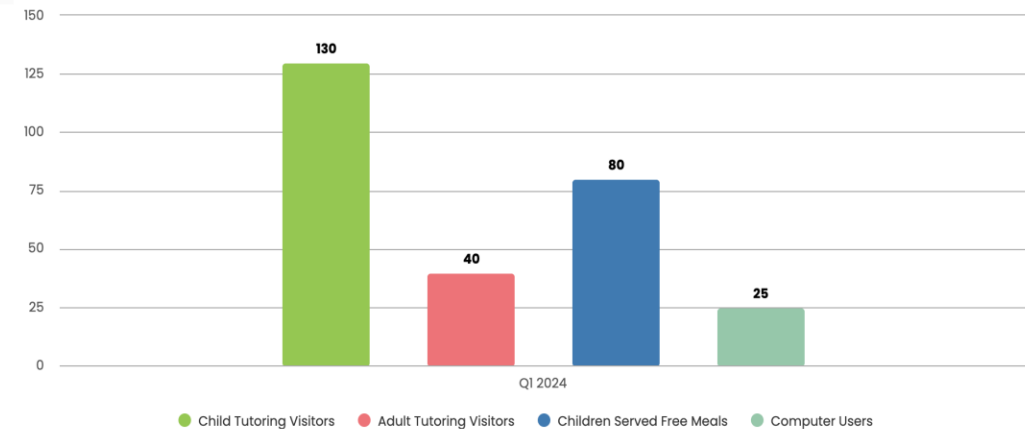
Programs

SAL has created infrastructure through its libraries to host life-changing courses including the computer literacy course which is vital to stay connected with the ever-evolving digital world. In addition, SAL plans to impact villages with various future programs

Computer Program Overview

- SAL utilizes an online eLearning platform (<https://sal-elearning.com/login>) to teach computer literacy skills including Generative AI, Coding, Graphic Design, Software Development, and Digital Marketing

Future Programs

- Income generating activities for the community to become self-sufficient including farming and soap-making
- Preventative health programs to diagnose health risk factors among the community using free diagnostic tests, depression screenings, and free health products
- Collaborate with other in-need rural villages to offer similar SAL services using a hub and spoke model

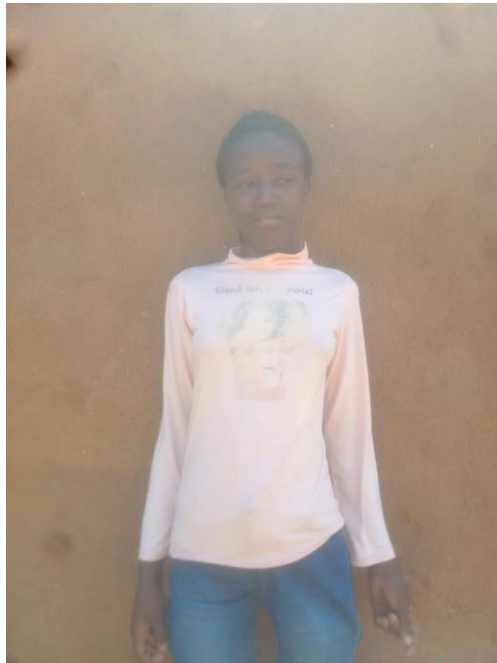

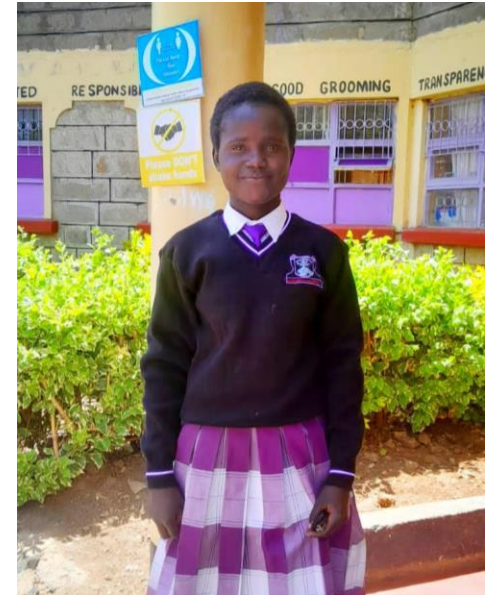

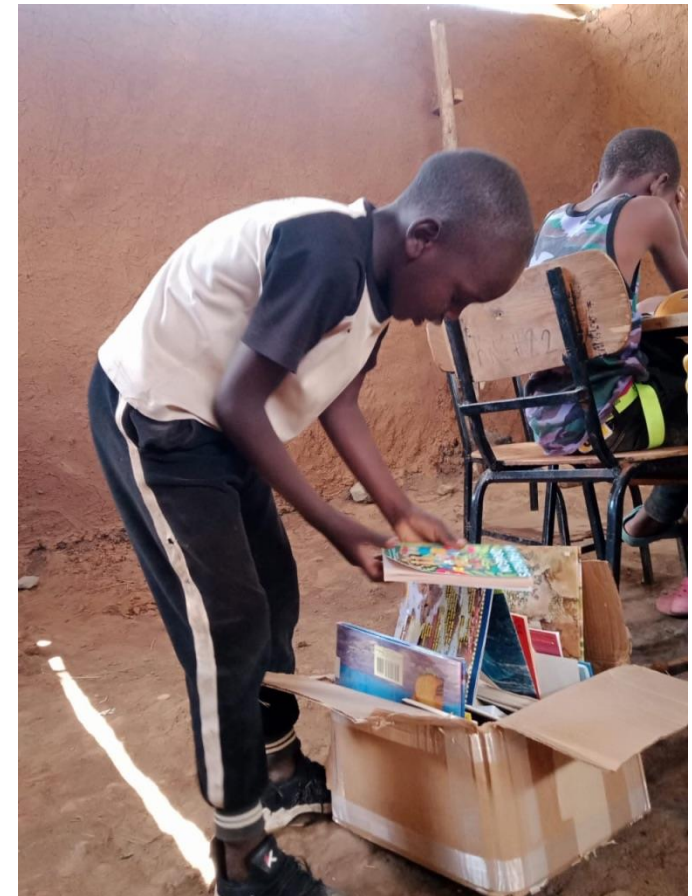
