

SHED A LIGHT SECOND QUARTER 2023 (APRIL - JUNE) REPORT

STUDENT ENGAGEMENTS

Schools were closed from April 5th to May 9th. During the holiday, we had increased attendance at the library with 1,595 total second guarter learner engagements

ADULT LITERACY

Adult engagement for the second guarter 2023 reached 632

FEEDING PROGRAM

The community nursery school had ten additional students join their program and therefore meals served increased for the second quarter to 5,476

COMPUTER CLASSES

Digital literacy has become very popular within the community ever since we introduced the computer class in February 2023, with second quarter computer engagements reaching 987

SPONSORSHIP

Three students under scholarship through Shed A Light reported back to school in May 2023 with their school fees fully paid! We are so excited about their progress in school, and recently conducted a school follow-up and we were impressed by the feedback we got from the school administration

CHALLENGES

- 1. Inadequate space to cater for the growing number of learners at the library
 - Library restoration & fencing estimated costs (required by 2024): ~1,500 USD
 - Library expansion estimated cost: ~8,000 USD
- 2. Need toilets and other sanitation in the library
 - Plumbing / toilet estimated cost: ~550 USD
- 3. Require 2024 sponsorship for our 3 currently sponsored secondary students
 - Per student estimated annual school fees: ~450 USD
