# 1. FEEDING PROGRAM

The feeding program continues to be a great success in the community as we see the increase in the attendance number of children. In August we served a total of 339 meals as indicated below;

5th September - 92 meals served  
12th September - 85 meals served  
19th September - 80 meals served  
26th September - 82 meals served



We have also been able to serve 1087 meals for the nursery school kids, making it a total of 1426 meals served in the month of September. At a time when the area is experiencing drought, the feeding program has been a blessing to so many children who are at a risk of starvation.

## 2. TUTORING PROGRAM AND LIBRARY

We continue to make great strides in our tutoring sessions. We have noticed the overall improvement in the grades of our students and great self esteem. We had a minimum of 22 children per day during our weekdays evening tutoring program and 65 during the weekend sessions. We had a total of 910 engagement sessions with the children.



Our challenge is the limited space to accommodate all the children at once so we have resolved to grouping them and tutoring them in shifts.



### **3. ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM**

This month we had a total of 382 engagement sessions. We are honored to impact such a life changing experience to our adult learners.

### **4. ACHIEVEMENTS IN SEPTEMBER**

- The nursery school was renovated.
- Built new desks, seats and shelves for the school.
