

MONTHLY REPORT MAY 2022

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1. FEEDING PROGRAM

Our feeding program is progressing well and we have managed to provide a total of 268 meals this month. Our numbers have gone up compared to the previous month and we are honored to be able to implement such a noble initiative for the needy children. For most of the children, this might be their only meal because most of their parents rely on casual work which is very limited especially at a period of drought which we are currently experiencing in the area. Some of the parents who also practice farming have experienced losses due to lack of rain and also most of the livestock have died due to starvation. The breakdown is as

2. TUTORING PROGRAM AND LIBRARY

The tutoring program has seen the increase in numbers of the children we tutor and this is a great indicator of the impact we are making in the community. The program runs daily in the evening on week days and whole day on Saturdays. In the month of May the sessions have been held from 4th to 31st of May and the numbers we have a daily minimum of 25 children who attend during the week and a minimum of 65 children



Our children were really excited when we received books and pencil donations from our donors. These have really boosted

our resource center materials.

3. ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM



With the goal of increasing the literacy levels in the community, the program has seen a consistency in the target numbers this month. The classes are offered on a daily basis during the week and a minimum of 14 adults attend the program on daily
