PLANNED ACTIVITIES FOR JUNE 2022

1. Feeding Program

Our feeding program is progressing well, and we have managed to provide a total of 315 meals this month. Our numbers have gone up compared to the previous month and we are honored to be able to implement such a noble initiative for the needy children. For most of the children, this might be their only meal. Many parents rely on casual work which is very limited especially during the current draft. Some of the parents who also practice farming have experienced losses due to lack of rain and most of the livestock have died due to starvation. The breakdown is as follows:


JUN 4th 78 children, JUN 14th 80 children, JUN 18th 79 children, JUN 25th 82 children

2. Tutoring Program and Library

The tutoring program attendance has increased, and this is a great indicator of the impact we are making on the community. The program runs every Monday through Saturday. In the month of June, the sessions have been held from 3rd to 30th of June with a daily minimum of 22 children who attend during the week and a minimum of 78 children during the weekend

3. Adult Literacy Program



With the goal of increasing the literacy levels in the community, the program has seen a consistency in the target numbers this month. The classes are offered daily during the week and 214 adults attended in June
